### INTERESTED IN PLAYING FOR YORKSHIRE?

Yorkshire Squash enters teams in all categories of the Inter-County Championships, ranging from Under 11's to over 65's

**ELIGIBILITY** Qualification for adults is by birth or a minimum of three months residence. You cannot play for another county at the same time, and a gap of one year must elapse if you are transferring from another county. Your qualifying age is that on the date of the match for which you may be selected. You must be a member of England Squash, either through your club or individually, and have a Membership number. You must also be registered with Club Locker by following the link <https://england.clublocker.com>. For Junior eligibility, see the regulations on the ES website

**SELECTION** Each team has a Team Manager who is responsible for selecting and organising the team, who you should contact to express your interest. See the full list on [www.yorkshiresquash.com](http://www.yorkshiresquash.com). It will assist him or her if you demonstrate your standard by playing in the County Championships, which are in September for Juniors and on 25/26 January at Pontefract Squash Club for Seniors (Open age) and Masters (35 upwards). **YORKSHIRE T SHIRTS** When representing Yorkshire, you must wear the official Yorkshire T shirt, which is a new design for adults for 2019-20. On the website [www.iprosports.co.uk](http://www.iprosports.co.uk), go to the Club section and scroll down to Yorkshire Squash. The first shirt is subsidised by Yorkshire Squash (enter the code YORKS at checkout), and there is a range of associated clothing available. You must place your order at least one month (see later) before the date of the first fixture, to allow time for production and posting to your home address.

**EXPENSES** Yorkshire Squash contributes towards the costs of travel and accommodation for matches beyond the Yorkshire boundary as follows. For car travel, distance from home to venue and return, at 20p per mile, maximum two cars per team (one car for teams of three). If more

than two cars are used, only two cars can be claimed for, but the Team Manager may share out the subsidy pro rata among all the drivers. For accommodation, Yorkshire Squash provides a subsidy of up to £25 per person (£45 for venues within the M25), for up to six people (four if three a side, and up to six players and two guardians if a five a side junior team) for one night, but two if the timing of the first match on the Saturday requires travel on the Friday. Players can be reimbursed in two ways. Either the Team Manager can reimburse each player during the event and then put one claim to the County Treasurer, or each player can notify the Team Manager of the amount which he or she is claiming, which can then be listed on the claim form (available on [www.yorkshiresquash.com](http://www.yorkshiresquash.com)) submitted by the Team Manager, and each player will then be reimbursed directly by the County Treasurer. In either case, the amounts claimed must be in accordance with the criteria above, and hotel receipts must accompany the claim form. Yorkshire Squash will also consider requests for additional financial support towards the costs of the Men's and Women's 1<sup>st</sup> teams, which may include payments to some players, in order to turn out the strongest teams possible

All expenses claims must be countersigned by the Team Organiser and sent to Peter Keen, Hon. Treasurer YSRA, 236, Dobcroft Road, Sheffield S11 9LJ or at [pckeen2000@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:pckeen2000@yahoo.co.uk), as soon as possible after each weekend of matches

**YOUR CHANCE OF SELECTION** The three categories – Juniors, Seniors and Masters – are each played on the same date, so logistically, players can usually only play for one team. This gives maximum opportunity for selection for interested players. We particularly welcome interest from women players interested in representing their County
